At their regular meeting April 25th, the Board:

- Heard the Superintendent and members provide the following Positive Highlights :
  - GMU Class of 2004 graduate Chelsea Theis appeared on the CBS Early Show April 23<sup>rd</sup> with other young women honored by New York Women In Communications Matrix Award Luncheon at the Waldorf-Astoria in New York City.
  - The Mock Trial Team lost by only one point to Unadilla Valley in the Chenango County round of competition.
  - Installation of security cameras by the Maintenance Department will result in a significant cost saving for the District.
  - Safety Committee Chair Jacquie Foster and Maintenance Supervisor Alan Digsby attended an American Red Cross Shelter course and are now qualified to operate a Red Cross shelter in the school. The Red Cross will reimburse the District for costs incurred in operating a shelter and will preposition cots, blankets and other emergency supplies at the school.
- Heard the Superintendent report on the initial meeting of the proposed building project Steering Committee and funding possibilities.
- Received financial reports for March.
- Approved the 2007-2008 BOCES Administrative Budget and voted for BOCES Board of Education candidates.
- Approved a request for transportation for the 2007-2008 school year.
