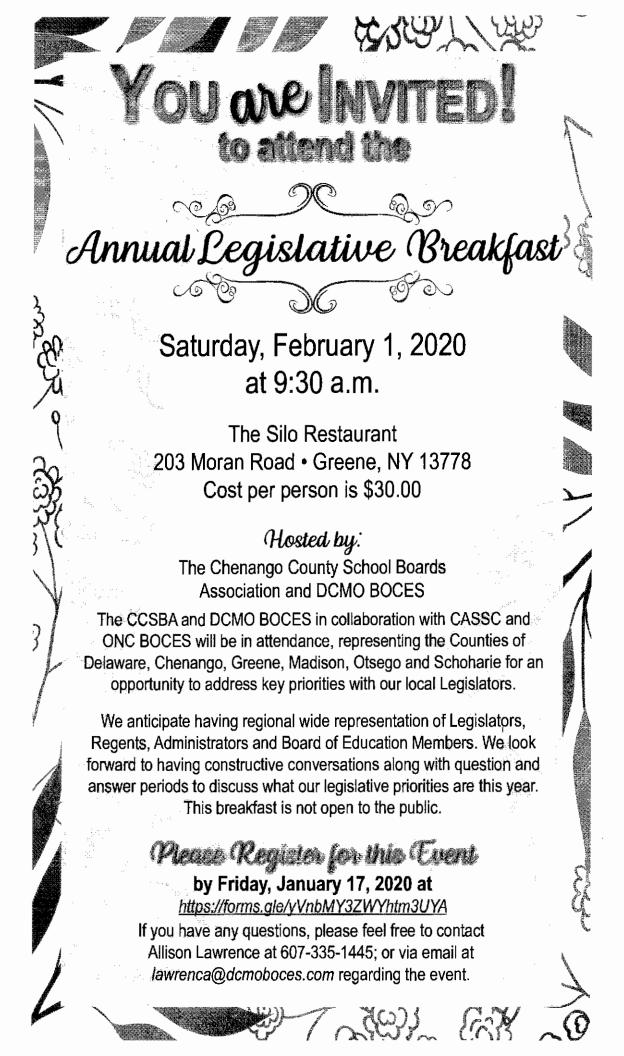

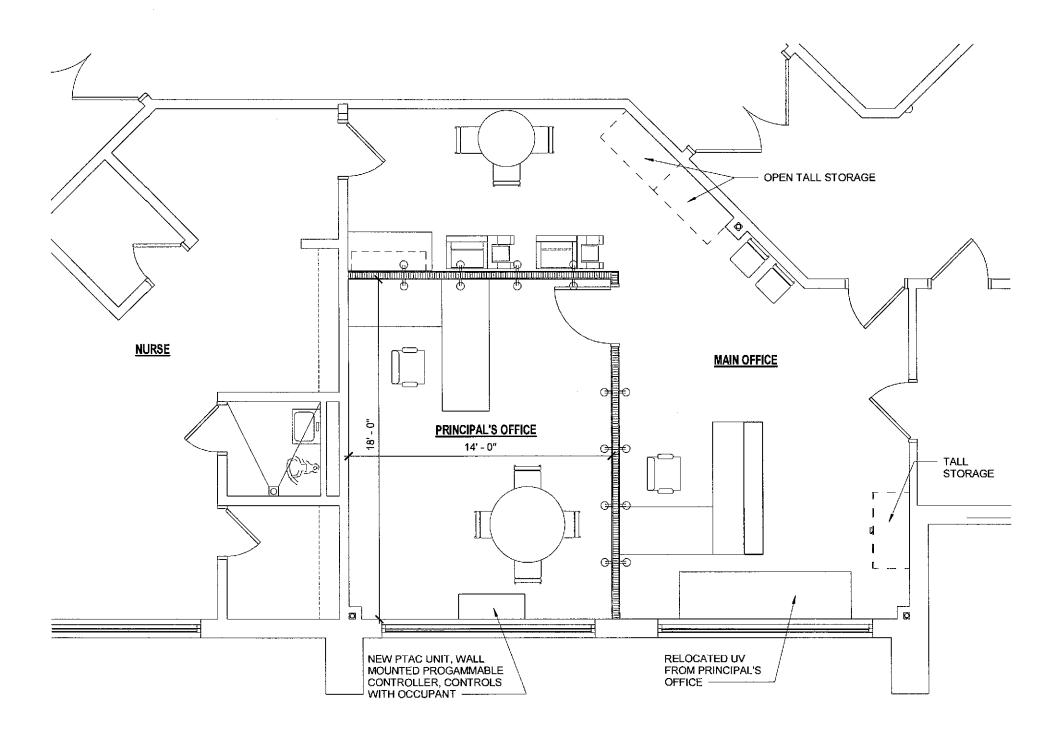

Re: Fire Inspection

On January 7, 2020 we conducted our annual Fire Safety Inspection of the PK-12 Building, Bus Garage and Press Box. The Inspection was conducted by Health and Safety Coordinator, Harold Ives and two members of the Gilbertsville Fire Department.

I am very happy to report to the Board of Education that we had only two violations of the three buildings that were inspected. A fish tank that was not plugged into a GFI receptacle and two bean bag chairs that did not have the manufactures approved label for fire retardant. These have both been corrected.
