Subject: Result of the Capital Project Vote - 30 July 2013

The results are as follows:

Proposition #1

Shall the following **RESOLUTION** be adopted:

RESOLVED, shall the Gilbertsville-Mount Upton Central School District, Otsego and Chenango Counties, New York, be authorized to reconstruct District buildings and facilities at the 693 State Highway 51 Campus in and for said School District, including site improvements, original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of \$2,230,000, and that \$2,230,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary after receipt of State Excel aid, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.

Shall the following **RESOLUTION** be adopted:

RESOLVED, shall the Gilbertsville-Mount Upton Central School District, Otsego and Chenango Counties, New York, be authorized to reconstruct additional District buildings and facilities at the 693 State Highway 51 Campus in and for said School District, including site improvements, original furnishings, equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, and incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,700,000, and that \$1,700,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary after, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.
